The Mobile Program is a Sail Nova Scotia program designed to introduce communities to the sport of sailing in the hopes that they will establish their own Learn to Sail programs.

The program, which will run from early July through mid August, includes 6 Optis and an Access Dinghy as well as a coach boat and motor and all the safety gear. All of the equipment is maintained regularly and is in excellent condition.

- Fully certified and current CANSail instructors (level 3-4 preferred) This includes valid First Aid & Coach Boat Safety Course.
- Excellent Communication and Organizational Skills
- At least one year coaching experience
