

## **Sail Nova Scotia Instructors for Mobile Sailing Program**

Sail Nova Scotia is seeking two Sail Canada certified instructors to run its Mobile Sailing Program in areas throughout Nova Scotia in Summer 2016.

The Mobile Program is a Sail Nova Scotia program designed to introduce communities to the sport of sailing in the hopes that they will establish their own Learn to Sail programs.

The program, which will run from early July through mid August, includes 6 Optis and a coach boat and motor and all the safety gear. All of the equipment is maintained regularly and is in excellent condition. Towing of equipment is left to host communities. Instructors do not need to tow using the rental car provided.

### **Ideal Candidates will have the following Qualities and Qualifications**

- Fully certified and current CANSail instructors (level 3-4 preferred) This includes valid First Aid & Coach Boat Safety Course.
- Excellent Communication and Organizational Skills
- At least one year coaching experience
- Valid Driver's License

While travel is required, a rental car will be provided. Host communities are responsible for towing the trailer.
